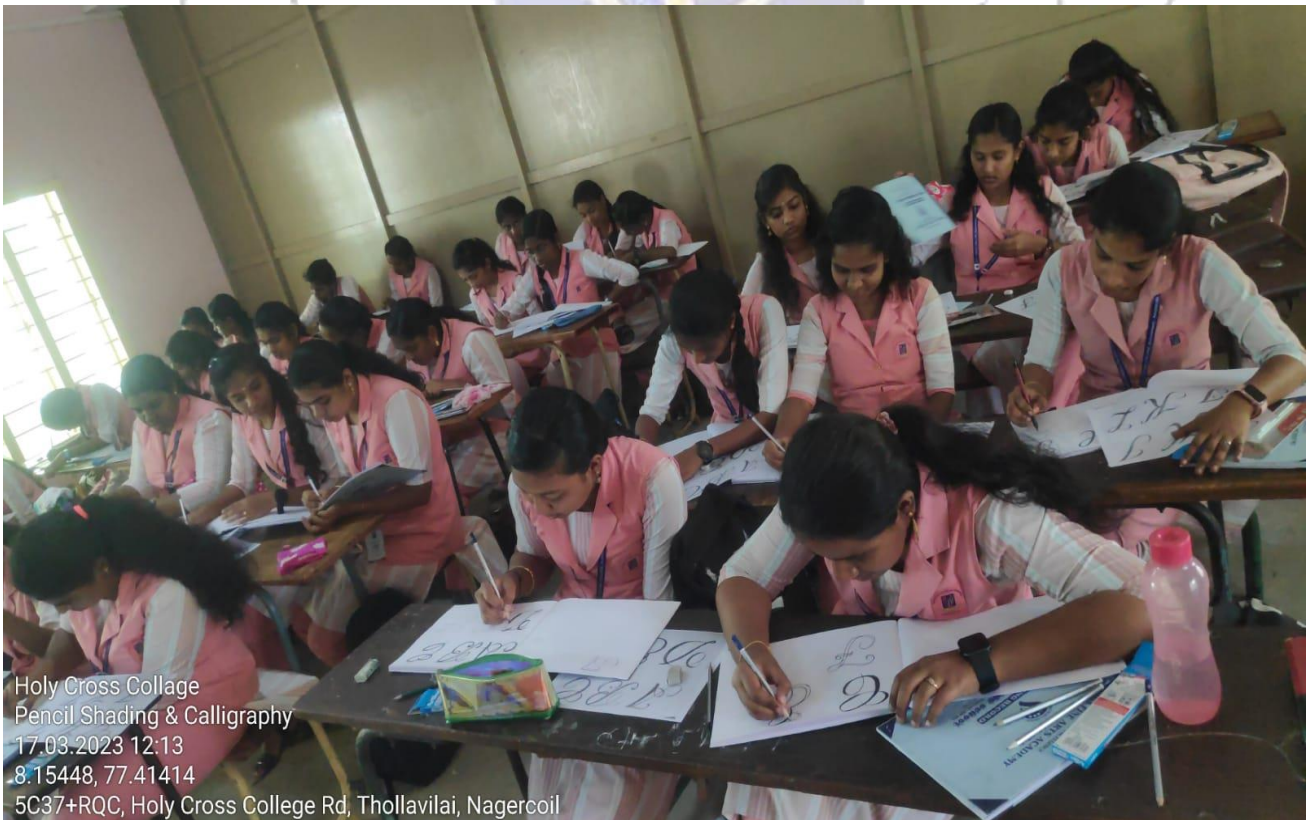
CERTIFICATE COURSES

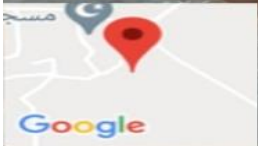
