**Responsibilities of AARUTHAL FOUNDATION (Dept. of Ardra Inter-Tech) Coimbatore.**


- Conducting training and workshops (online/offline) to students for every Semester (Odd & Even).

**Duration of MoU**


The MoU shall expire in Two years after the date specified in this document. However, the MoU shall be extended for another 3 (three) years by mutual consent.

**General**





This college is an Arts and Science College with U.G, P.G and Research Programmes. It is rendering service to the student community since 1965 which helps in the uplift of the society. The Department of Botany has U.G, P. and Research programmes. From the department, every year around 160 students are graduated.

### **Institute of Complimentary and Traditional Medicine.**

**Institute of Complimentary and Traditional Medicine**, is a reputed local body established at Chennai having experts in Herbal products Formulation, Manufacturing, Marketing and Health Service of Health Education. It has branches all over South India doing marketing herbal products and also having rapport with many educational institutions. The parties thereof had a discussion and the terms and conditions were accepted under a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU). Now this MoU witnessed that the Head of the Department of Botany, Holy Cross College (Autonomous), Nagercoil agrees the following:

- It shall be responsible to provide around 160 students (3 streams) and all infrastructural facilities required to give lecture on herbal medicine
- It shall cooperate with the faculty of Institute of Complimentary and Traditional Medicine, Chennai in arranging hands on training programme
- It shall be responsible to get feedback from the participants and send a report to the Manager, Institute of Complimentary and Traditional Medicine, Chennai.

- It shall arrange 6 hours lecture to the students of Department of Botany during the III Semester to substantiate the curriculum in the course of 'Herbal Botany'.
- It shall help the Department of Botany in preparing the study materials. It is agreed by the parties thereof that this MoU is valid for the period of **two** years starting from the academic year **2018-2019**. The MoU can be terminated with 45 days notice. It is agreed that the MoU may be renewed after the said period, if needed.
