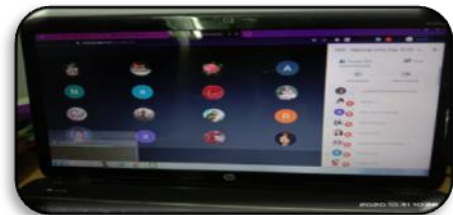
08.10.2020 - The COVID-19 awareness meeting cum pledge was conducted by the NSS.

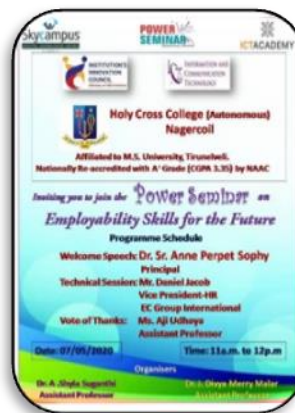
