- All designs must be painted free-hand (no stencils, masks or artificial enhancements).
- Models to be arranged by the participants themselves.
- Judging will be based on originality, creativity and difficulty.

Interdepartmental Face Painting Competition (30.09.2025)

Theme: Youth Against Ragging

General Rules and Conditions

- Each participant must bring their own materials, including paints, brushes, water containers, sponges and any other required tools.
- Sharing of materials between participants is strictly prohibited.
- Reference photos or drawings are not allowed; all designs must be created free-hand.
- Participants are advised to familiarize themselves with the rules before the event.
- Non-compliance with rules will result in point reduction or disqualification.

Permitted Materials:

- Professional makeup/ paints designed specifically for skin (including metallic and neon).
- Products may be applied wet or dry.
- Skin-safe adhesives and removers.
- Brushes, sponges, sponge-tipped applicators, stylus tools and paintbrush ends for dotting.
- Glitter (loose powder or liquid form).
- Skin-safe gemstones (self-adhesive or with skin-safe adhesive).
- Any other skin-friendly, safe-to-use materials.

Not Permitted:

- Stencils or stamps.
- Masks covering any part of the face.
- False eyelashes, contact lenses, novelty eyeglasses or sunglasses.

Competition Day Rules

- Participants and their models must report at the designated check-in time.
- Upon check-in, a competition number will be issued to each participant.
- Only two participants per team; tables and chairs will be provided.
- Models may not assist in the design.
- Models must remain available for judging immediately after the competition.
- All materials will be inspected before the start of the competition to ensure compliance.

Judging Guidelines

- Judging will be conducted immediately after the competition.
- Judges will not be present during the competition and will remain anonymous.
- Models must not reveal the identity of the participant to the judges.

Criteria (Maximum Score: 30 points | 10 points per category):

- Originality Is the design unique, innovative or a refreshing take on an existing idea?
- Creativity Does the design display artistic vision, imagination and thoughtful execution?
- Difficulty Does the design demonstrate technical skill and complexity?

Any violation of rules may lead to point reduction or disqualification at the discretion of the judges.
